BEST DADS: Nurturing Fathers Program* - \$10 Registration Fee. 6:00PM - 8:00PM Mondays

This 10-week course will explore topics such as discipline & creative play, fathering sons & daughters, teamwork with spouse & coparent, communication & problem-solving, and balancing work & fathering.

BEST MOMS: Nurturing Mothers Program - \$10 Registration Fee 6:00PM - 8:00PM Mondays.

This 10-week program includes topics that address age- and stage specific aspects of child growth, parent/child communication skills, positive discipline, helping the child develop positive self-esteem, and dealing with stress.

Branching Out‡ (No Fee!)

1st Wednesday of every month (Lafayette) 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 & 2nd Wednesday of every month (Crowley) 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Branching Out is a support group for moms that offers empowerment, support and therapeutic guidance in a peaceful setting. Branching Out works to nurture connections through moms and their children, one branch at a time. Child care is provided.

Anger Choices - Individual Series \$75/session - Group Sessions \$150

Individual Sessions scheduled per client's request – Group Sessions (6 week series) 6:00PM – 7:00PM Tuesdays

Helps participants learn how to reduce and eliminate self-defeating and angry reactions. In these sessions, the participant will explore what defines anger and how to choose reactions that are less harmful to self and others. Both individual and small group sessions available.

Active Parenting of Teens* - \$10 Registration Fee 6:00PM - 8:00PM Tuesdays

Do you want to have a better relationship with your teen and/or 'tween? If so, this 6-week education series is for you. This series focuses on effective discipline, teaching responsibility, and communication with teens and 'tweens. See the difference in your teens: improved grades, greater confidence, better behavior, and happier family life for all! Parent must enroll teen in Teens in Action class!

Teens in Action* - \$10 Registration Fee 6:00PM - 8:00PM Tuesdays

This 6-week class is designed for use with kids ages 11-16. This workshop series will address the issues of self-image, emotion, communication, power struggles, and peer pressure in order to fully equip students with facing the challenges of school and community involvement. Parents must enroll in Active Parenting of Teens!

TransParenting - Formally "Children Cope with Divorce" Parents Only! (No children please) - - \$75 due at time of registration 5:30PM – 9:30PM 2nd Thursday of Every Month

This 4-hour parent seminar is designed to help parents minimize the negative impact of divorce / separation on children. Parent workbook & companion website are included.

Rollercoasters : \$10 Registration Fee 5:30PM - 7:30PM 3rd Thursday of Every Month

This 2-hour program is offered as a supplement to TransParenting. It is designed for children who are experiencing parental separation and divorce, and includes three versions tailored to address the specific needs of participants. Primary curriculum for children ages 5-8. Intermediate curriculum for ages 9-12. Teen curriculum for ages 13 and up. Parents must register and attend Transparenting.

Flood Recovery Support Group[^] (No Fee!) 4:00PM -5:00PM Tuesdays

FREE one hour support group for any adult who has been affected by the historic flooding that occurred in August 2016. Join us for an opportunity to connect with others experiencing similar circumstances, share your thoughts and feelings, and learn coping skills.
